Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your family have had a wonderful and restful break. My name is Miss Plummer, and I am delighted to be joining Fountain Primary School this year as a Primary 3 and 4 teacher. In Primary 3 and 4 this year we will be having toast or crackers each morning. If your child wishes to avail of this, it will cost 50p per week. The money should be paid on a Monday morning for the week.

If your child would like a snack at breaktime they are able to buy a snack from the canteen or alternatively they can bring their own healthy snack. If your child pays for dinner, please send their money on a Monday in a labelled envelope. Dinners are £2.60 per day or £13 for the week.

All children should bring their own water bottle to school. The water bottle must be kept in their bag when not using it. They can refill it in school throughout the day if required. Remember juice or flavoured water is not allowed in school.

P.E will be on a **Thursday** and children are allowed to come in, in their P.E. uniform on that day.

I have provided a list of suggested equipment that would be beneficial for your child in class. We do have a certain amount of equipment in class but unfortunately not enough for all children for the full school year.
